BGHC SCHOLARSHIPS

BGHC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Each year the BGHC awards scholarship(s) in support of our players in their post secondary pursuits. Players interested in applying for a BGHC scholarship must complete the following application within the given criteria. Priority given to applicants who have demonstrated a history of commitment to the BGHC as a player and volunteer.

Scholarship Award Eligibility Criteria:

i) Must currently be a player or member of the coaching staff of a team in the Burlington Girls Hockey Club.

ii) Must have a minimum of 3 consecutive years with the BGHC as a player and/or member of a coaching staff.

iii) Must be intending to pursue post-secondary education in the coming academic year.
iv) The scholarship winner will demonstrate evidence of a history of involvement within the BGHC organization beyond that stated above for eligibility, including but not limited to volunteering, mentoring, assistant coaching, and/or refereeing.

Applicants should submit a short essay on their own behalf outlining how they meet the defined criteria, and why they feel they should be chosen as the award recipient. Applications must be submitted via email to <u>communications@bghc.ca</u> no later than March 24th, 2024
