Becky Kellar is a four-time Olympian who played in 20 games, recorded 9 points and captured 3 Gold Medals (Salt Lake City 2002, Turin 2006, Vancouver 2010) and 1 Silver (Nagano 1998).

Becky was inducted to the Canadian Olympic Hall of Fame in 2012 with her teammates from the Turin 2006 Olympic hockey team.

Jana Harrigan has an extensive hockey career receiving a scholarship from Ohio State University, holding 2nd for the record of all time points at Ohio State (160) and was awarded the "All American."
