Components of the BGHC Fee

The BGHC fee attempts to capture all costs that the BGHC will incur on behalf of each specific Rep team. The components of this fee include:

- ice allocations for:
 - summer ice (booked by May 31st and requested by team to be included in the BGHC),
 - September ice estimated per team and communicated to the teams in early May, hours vary depending on playing level
 - in-season practice and game ice as per the master ice schedule
- HOME and AWAY Rep player jerseys and socks (17 per team)
- for U18AA, U15AA and U13AA – third jersey set (17 per team)
- other allocations for:
 - non-parent coach mileage reimbursements for the Rep program non-parent coaches at U18AA, U15AA, U13AA, U11AA, U18A, U15A and U13A
 - agreed association support of the U22AA team
 - cost of the head referee, who assigns all on-ice officials and timekeepers
 - cost of mandatory volunteer certifications including coach certifications
 - BGHC overhead
- SHIELD development program costs for U9 through U13 teams, except for U13AA
- Goalie support program allocations for U9 through U15 teams
- OWHA per player and staff registration fees
- OWHA per team registration fees (\$325 per team)
- OWHA provincial bond (\$200 per team)
- staff apparel allowance at \$500 per team,
- team SNAP
- BGHC supplied coaching supplies

Components of the Rep Team Budget

The Rep Team budget consists of expenditures that are at the discretion of each team.

Depending on the team, this fee will consist of some or all of the following. Other amounts may be included at the discretion of the team, as approved by the parent group.

- team-specific development
- goalie development allotment of a minimum of \$1,000 per goalie
- tournament entry fees
- practice jerseys/extra game jerseys as needed for potential call up players that may not have a jersey
- team apparel mandated by the team coaching staff PROVIDED THAT ALL PLAYERS REQUIRE THE APPAREL
- staff apparel
- anticipated ice beyond the BGHC allocation included in the BGHC fee
- referees and timekeepers for all games
- trainer supplies
- team social functions, luncheons, parties/ team gifts for players and staff as agreed
- non-parent coach out-of-pocket expenses for out-of-town exhibition games and tournaments, as applicable, within set limits
